**New NHS Capital Funding - Central & North West London NHS  
Foundation Trust**

I am delighted to let you know that as part of our Long Term Plan for the NHS, the following investments will be made in your constituency. We strongly support our NHS and want to help it to be the best it can be. Today's investment shows we are making reality of that support in your area.

We are funding the **Oak Tree Ward - Woodlands Mental Health Wards Reconfiguration, Hillingdon** scheme with new investment of up to £0.502 million which will deliver single sex bedrooms on adult inpatient mental health wards at Oak Tree Ward.

This is part of £1bn extra capital funding being announced across England. It comes on top of the £20.5bn per year extra funding for the NHS over the next five years - the longest and largest funding settlement in the NHS's history. The investment is part of the wider plan to provide better services for patients, integrate care better and renew aging facilities.

The increased funding and the Long Term Plan demonstrates our abiding commitment to the NHS so the NHS can be there for all of us, free at the point of use, long into the future.
