
Thank you for your letter dated 27 October 2021 about your strong belief for the Uxbridge Police Station to be retained in light of the current MOPAC/MPS Estates Strategy review. I am sorry for the delay in replying.

The Metropolitan Police Service (MPS) is finalising its review of all the Mayor's Office for Policing And Crime's (MOPAC's) buildings across London, identifying those which need to be retained and those sites that will become surplus. As part of the review MOPAC will take into account the promised extra officers, expected workforce changes, operational requirements and future finances. In addition, review will take the opportunity to consider the impact of and opportunities presented by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Upon completion of the MPS review, MOPAC will scrutinise the plans and the resulting Estates Strategy. This will include the plans for Uxbridge Police Station.
